Guidelines and Expectations Covenant**

We are the youth of First UMC – La Porte and we want to glorify God in everything we do by setting a good example, showing respect and participating in activities!

We set a good EXAMPLE!

- We are appropriate in our language and gestures. (Examples: Remove hats when praying & refrain from use of bad language.)
- We are drug, tobacco, alcohol and violence free!
- We exhibit AGAPE LOVE (brotherly & sisterly) which means NO EXCESSIVE PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION (PDA).
- **We are appropriate in our clothing**, remembering that we are an example of Christ. ***“adorn yourself in modesty” Job 40:10***
 - Clothes should not be overly tight.
 - No spaghetti straps, muscles shirts, tube tops, t-shirts with offensive or inappropriate messages.
 - Shorts should be of modest length.
 - Pants should stay at the waist.
 - **Swimsuits should be modest, preferably one piece. Tankini suits are allowed. If two piece, a DARK t-shirt may need to be worn over it.**
 - Nothing should be see-through, backless, strapless or with holes in inappropriate places.
 - **Girls: the 5 B’s** must be covered (belly, bra, bust, behind, & back).

We show RESPECT!

- We respect adults, fellow youth group members and visitors regardless of their sex, race, national origin or disability.
- We respect church property as well as other property at which there is an event.
- We are respectful in our use of cell phones, turning them off completely or on silent.
- We respect whoever is leading a program, youth or adult, by not talking while they are speaking and by paying attention to whoever took the time to spend time with us.
- We are respectful by leaving an activity only if the event is over or if a parent or youth has personally notified an adult leader.
